Allesverloren Tinta Barocca R220 ★★★

Riebeek-West - WO Swartland (Est. 1704)

Leading wine from rare grape in SA. Full-bodied, fruity, plum and fynbos on balance. Lightly oaked. Recommended with the fillet. 14% Alc. /Vol.

Alto Estate Rouge R190 ★★★★★

Paradyskloof - WO Stellenbosch (Est. 1906)

Fantastic old favourite - blend of Shiraz and Bordeaux. Ripe fruitcake nose. Really!

Paarl - WO Coastal (Est. 1916)

Graceful Cabernet/Merlot blend. Well-balanced with long savoury conclusion. Maybe with the stroganoff? 14% Alc. /Vol.

Paarl - WO Coastal (Est. 1916)

Belies its lowly rating. A lovely, lightly-oaked Merlot which slips down very easily. This is also a kosher wine. 14% Alc. /Vol.

Accessible juicy melange, mostly Cabernet Sauvignon with some Shiraz and Cabernet Franc.
